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What is Progress Monitoring?

Progress Monitoring is a **standardized process** involving **frequent and routine** assessment of specific academic, behavioral, and/or functional **skills**.

Data collected through progress monitoring is used to:

- **Determine** the rate of improvement
- **Examine and evaluate** the responsiveness to and effectiveness of instruction
- **Measure** progress toward goals
- **Communicate** with parents
- **Celebrate** success!

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Why Progress Monitor?



The IEP must contain a statement of:

- How the child's **progress toward the annual goals ... will be measured**; and
- How the child's parents will be regularly informed through means such as periodic report cards as often as parents of nondisabled children of:
 - The child's **progress towards the annual goal**
 - The extent to which the **progress is sufficient** to enable the child to **achieve the goals** by the end of the IEP year.

IDEA (300.320) and NC Policies (1503-4.1)



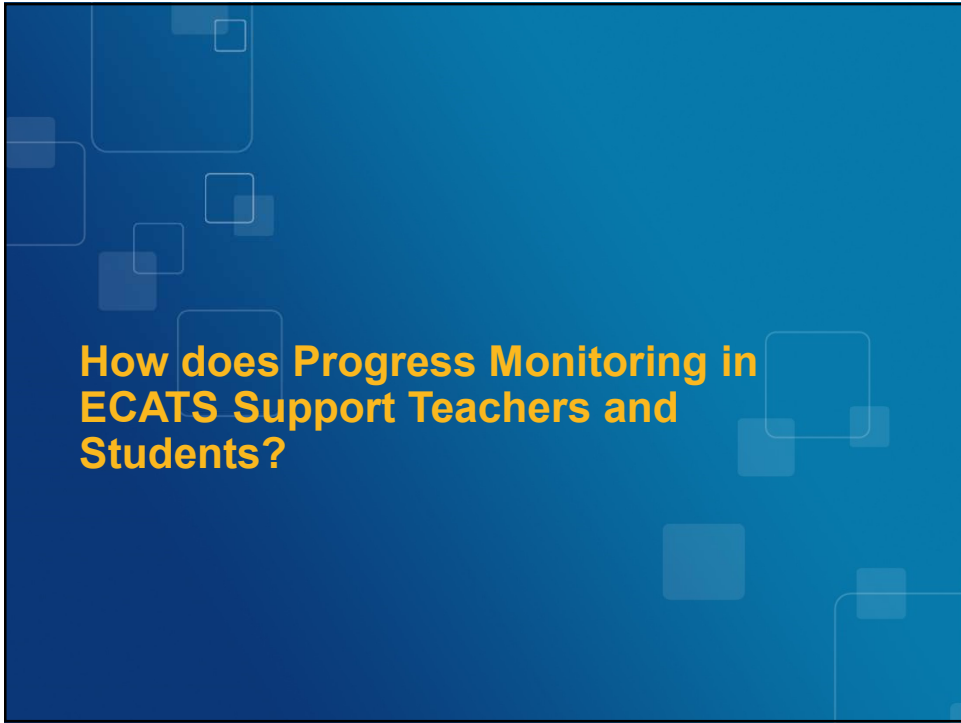
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When electronic progress monitoring is implemented, educators build habits and incorporate progress monitoring requirements into their daily activities. At the same time, data collection is simplified and becomes well integrated in students' IEPs and classrooms.

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How does ECATS Progress Monitoring Support Teachers and Students?



- Standardized Tool to Track Progress on IEP Goals
- Provides Graphical Representation of Progress for Parents and IEP Team Members
- Promotes meaningful conversation with parents on student progress
- Provides the quantitative data to support qualitative Progress Reports for Parents

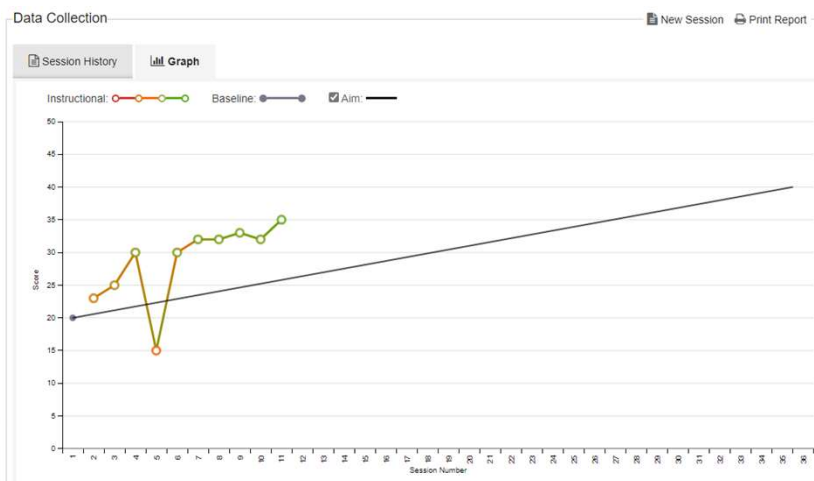

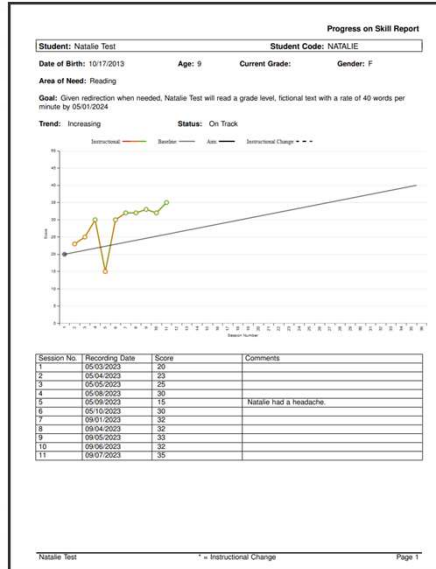

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Strategies for Implementation

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Strategize and Plan



Define your **district's expectations** around Progress Monitoring

- Will it be mandatory or optional?
- What is the frequency progress should be reported for each goal area?
- Monitoring Personnel of the tool (i.e., EC office personnel, school level admin)

Provide **Progress Monitoring Documentation** to share out district expectations, instructional programming, and progress monitoring tools.



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Teamwork



Appoint a **district and/or campus level point-person** to be focused on Progress Monitoring & Data Collection

Strategic use of campus-based Progress Monitoring **Champion Teachers** to assist and support fellow educators



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Training



Provide training on using the Progress Monitoring Tool, including acceptable data collection sources and measurable annual IEP goals.

- Train the Trainer vs. All End Users
- Rolling start as IEP meetings are held
- Campus and district champion role
- What do users do with the data from Progress Monitoring?

Review **District Expectations** to ensure user understanding

- Monitor Adoption on the Campus or District Level



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Support




Offer **support working sessions** for teachers to come and work through questions they may have about the Progress Monitoring Tool.

Ongoing district engagement is essential for success with Progress Monitoring.
